



Architectural-Engineering Corporation **Reinstatement** Application Instructions

The legislature has enacted laws which govern all firms practicing architecture in Louisiana. In accordance with those laws, the LSBAE has adopted rules which regulate the registration of such firms. All firms practicing architecture in Louisiana are required to register with the LSBAE and receive a Certificate of Authority within thirty days following registration with the Secretary of State. You should consult your legal counsel or CPA regarding the need for business registration with the Louisiana Secretary of State.

To register as an Architectural-Engineering Corporation, your firm must include one or more Louisiana licensed architect(s) in order to meet the definition of an Architectural-Engineering Corporation within the meaning of [La. R. S. 12:1171](#). To register as an A-E Corporation, such firm must be lawfully incorporated, and must apply with the LSBAE **and** with the Louisiana Professional Engineering and Land Surveying Board ([LAPELS](#)), designating therein a supervising Louisiana registered architect and a supervising Louisiana registered engineer. Upon receipt of completed application and the appropriate fee, the architectural-engineering corporation will have its Certificate of Authority renewed and will be authorized to practice **architecture** in the state of Louisiana, unless the application is disapproved. This authority will expire on June 30th of the following year unless it is renewed prior to that date.

Fees: A delinquent fee equal to the renewal fee of \$75 (in-state) or \$150 (out-of-state) will be assessed in addition to the regular renewal fee of \$75 (in-state) or \$150 (out-of-state) for a total of \$150 or \$300, respectively.

Said statute further provides that persons designated must be full-time active employees of the corporation and whose primary occupation is with that corporation.

This authority will expire on June 30th of the following year unless it is renewed prior to that date. Failure to renew in a timely manner will result in fines and penalties.

Fees: A delinquent fee equal to the renewal fee of \$75 (in-state) or \$150 (out-of-state) will be assessed in addition to the regular renewal fee of \$75 (in-state) or \$150 (out-of-state) for a total of \$150 (in-state) or \$300 (out-of-state), respectively.

Any certification renewed pursuant to this application shall be for the practice of **Architecture** in Louisiana. Authority to practice engineering in Louisiana must be obtained from the Louisiana Professional Engineering & Land Surveying Board ([LAPELS](#)).
