**JUDGMENT**


This matter came on for hearing in open court on December 5, 2018 for confirmation of preliminary default. Present: Paul H. Spaht, attorney for plaintiff, Louisiana State Board of Architectural Examiners (“LSBAE”), and Tyson J. Ducote, Deputy Director of the LSBAE. The Court finding that the defendant, Aaron Robinson (“Robinson”), was personally served with citation and a certified copy of the Petition for Preliminary and Permanent Injunctions and Civil Penalty via the Louisiana long-arm statute, R.S. 13:3201 et seq., on October 11, 2018; that an Affidavit of Service was filed in the record on October 16, 2018 showing the date, place, and manner of service; that a preliminary default was entered against the defendant on November 28, 2018, and the Court finding the law and evidence in favor of the plaintiff, LSBAE, and against the defendant, Aaron Robinson, for oral reasons assigned:

IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that there be judgment in favor of the plaintiff, Louisiana State Board of Architectural Examiners, and against the defendant, Aaron Robinson, permanently enjoining, restraining and prohibiting Aaron Robinson and his agents, servants, and employees: (i) from using the name re:design architectural studios in Louisiana; (ii) from using the website of re:design architectural studios, any other website, and any other title, sign, advertisement, or other device to indicate that he practices or offers to practice architecture, or renders architectural services, or is an architect, in Louisiana, and (iii) from practicing or offering to practice architecture, or from rendering architectural services, in Louisiana.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that there be judgment in favor of the plaintiff, Louisiana State Board of Architectural Examiners, and against the defendant, Aaron Robinson, awarding the Louisiana State Board of Architectural Examiners a civil penalty against Aaron Robinson in the amount of Six Thousand Two Hundred Twenty Four and 16/100 Dollars (\$6,224.16).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that all costs of these proceedings are to be paid by the defendant, Aaron Robinson.
