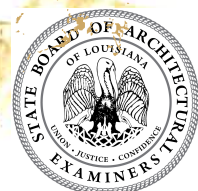
CONSENT ORDER

The Louisiana State Board of Architectural Examiners [hereinafter the "Board"], by and through its Executive Director, pursuant to authorization by the Board, and David L. Glasgow, [hereinafter "Respondent"], hereby agree to the following:

At all times material hereto, Respondent was licensed in the State of Louisiana as an architect, number 5595.

An investigation was opened based upon the Board's receipt of information which suggested that Respondent had acted as the supervising professional architect for *New Orleans Design Group, LLC* from 2019 through May 2023, submitted the initial application for registration of such firm in 2019 (therein designating himself as the supervising professional architect of such firm), and submitted certificate of authority renewal applications for *New Orleans Design Group, LLC* in 2021 and 2022 (again certifying therein that he was the supervising professional architect for that architectural firm), despite Respondent having never been actively employed by that firm on a full-time basis.

La. R.S. 37:153(A)(6) authorizes the Board to take disciplinary action against any licensed architect who violates any provisions of the Architect Licensing Law. La. R.S. 37:153(A)(7) prohibits licensed architects from practicing any fraud, deceit, material misstatement, or perjury in applying for any renewal certificate. La. R.S. 37:158(A), *to wit* LAC Title 46:I §1705(G) requires the supervising professional architect of an architectural firm to be a full-time active employee of that firm whose primary occupation is with that



firm. La. R.S. 37:158(A), *to wit* LAC Title 46:I §1705(J) places the responsibility for all acts and conduct of an architectural firm upon the architect designated as that firm's supervising professional architect. La. R.S. 37:153(A)(6), La. R.S. 37:153(A)(7), La. R.S. 37:158(A), LAC Title 46:I §1705(G), and LAC Title 46:I §1705(J) were in effect at all times material hereto.

It is undisputed that Respondent **(a)** acted as the supervising professional architect for *New Orleans Design Group, LLC* from 2019 through May 2023, and **(b)** submitted the initial application for registration in 2019 and the certificate of authority renewal applications for *New Orleans Design Group, LLC* in 2021 and 2022, certifying on all such applicaitons that he was the supervising professional architect for that architectural firm despite Respondent having never been actively employed by the firm on a full-time basis.

By letter dated December 6, 2024, the Committee gave notice to Respondent that it was considering the preferral of charges against him on the grounds that he may have violated La. R.S. 37:153(A)(6), La. R.S. 37:153(A)(7), La. R.S. 37:158(A), LAC Title 46:I §1705(G), and LAC Title 46:I §1705(J) relative to his acting as the supervising professional architect for *New Orleans Design Group, LLC* and his submitting the initial application for registration and certificate of authority renewal applications for such firm designating himself as the supervising professional architect when he had never been actively employed on a full-time basis at such firm.

Wishing to dispense with the need for further disciplinary action and to conclude the instant proceeding without further delay and expense, and for the purpose of this proceeding only, Respondent and the Board do hereby enter into this Consent Order, in which Respondent of his own free will consents to the issuance of a Consent Order by the Board, wherein Respondent agrees to **(a)** pay a fine of two-thousand and no/100 (\$2,000.00) dollars, **(b)** pay administrative costs of five-hundred sixty-two and 06/100 dollars (\$562.06), **(c)** completing, with a minimum score of 80%, the Board's online *Laws & Rules Quiz* for which no continuing education credit will be awarded, due upon the signing of this Consent Order; **(e)** the immediate and automatic suspension of his Louisiana architect

license in the event Respondent fails to comply with any sanction contained within this Consent Order, until all such sanctions are satisfied; (f) publication of this Consent Order on the Board's website and a summary of this matter in the Board's official newsletter, *Louisiana Architect*, to read, "David L. Glasgow (hereinafter 'Respondent'), an architect (license #5595), was subject to disciplinary action by the Board for (a) acting as the supervising professional architect for New Orleans Design Group, LLC from 2019 through May 2023 and (b) submitting the initial application for registration in 2019 and certificate of authority renewal applications for New Orleans Design Group, LLC in 2021 and 2022, certifying thereon that he was the supervising professional architect for that architectural firm despite Respondent having never been actively employed by that firm on a full-time basis in violation of La. R.S. 37:153(A)(6), La. R.S. 37:153(A)(7), La. R.S. 37:158(A), LAC Title 46:I §1705(G), and LAC Title 46:I §1705(J). Respondent has entered into a Consent Order with the Board wherein he admitted to the referenced violations of the above laws and rules and agreed to pay a fine of \$2,000; to pay administrative costs of \$562.06; to successfully complete, with a minimum score of 80% the Board's online Laws & Rules Quiz for which no continuing education credit will be awarded, due upon the signing of this Consent Order; to the immediate and automatic suspension of his Louisiana architect license in the event he fails to comply with any sanction contained within this Consent Order, until all such sanctions are satisfied; to the publication of this Consent Order on the Board's website; to the printing of a summary of this matter in the official newsletter of the Board, Louisiana Architect, identifying Respondent by name; and to the reporting of this matter to the National Council of Architectural Registration Boards ('NCARB') Disciplinary Database, identifying Respondent by name."; and (h) to the reporting of this matter to the National Council of Architectural Registration Boards ("NCARB") Disciplinary Database, identifying Respondent by name.

Respondent admits that his conduct as set forth above constitutes violations of the above-referenced laws and rules as stated herein. Respondent acknowledges that this Consent Order constitutes a disciplinary action by the Board against him and his Louisiana license to practice architecture. Respondent also acknowledges awareness of said laws and/or rules and states that he will comply with all applicable laws and rules henceforth.

Respondent has been advised of his right to be represented by counsel before the Board and/or to appear at any hearing personally or by counsel and present witnesses and evidence on his own behalf; he hereby waives these rights and his right to appeal, and he states affirmatively that he has been afforded all administrative remedies due him under the law. Respondent further acknowledges awareness of the fact that the signed original of this Consent Order will remain in the custody of the Board as a public record and will be made available for public inspection and copying upon request.

Therefore, in consideration of the foregoing and by signing this Consent Order, Respondent does hereby waive his right to a hearing before the Board, to the presenting of evidence and witnesses on his behalf, to Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law in this case, and to judicial review of this Consent Order.

Respondent hereby represents that (a) he fully understands the meaning and intent of this Consent Order, including but not limited to its final and binding effect, (b) he has voluntarily entered into this Consent Order, and that no other promise or agreement of any kind has been made to or with him by any person whatsoever to cause the execution of this instrument, and (c) the sanctions set forth in this Consent Order do not prevent the Board from taking further disciplinary or enforcement action against Respondent on matters not specifically addressed in this Consent Order.

WHEREFORE, the Louisiana State Board of Architectural Examiners and Respondent agree that:

1. Respondent shall pay a fine of two-thousand and no/100 (\$2,000.00) dollars, which shall be tendered to the Board by certified check payable to the Treasurer, State of Louisiana, due upon the signing of this Consent Order; and

2. Respondent shall pay administrative costs of five-hundred sixty-two and 06/100 dollars (\$562.06), which shall be tendered to the Board by certified check payable to the Louisiana State Board of Architectural Examiners, due upon the signing of this Consent Order; and

3. Respondent shall successfully complete, with a minimum score of 80%, the Board's online *Laws & Rules Quiz* for which no continuing education credit will be awarded, due upon the signing of this Consent Order; and

4. In the event Respondent fails to comply with any sanction contained within this Consent Order, his Louisiana architect license shall be immediately and automatically suspended until all such sanctions are satisfied; and

5. This Consent Order shall be published on the Board's website, a summary of this matter shall be printed in the official newsletter of the Board, *Louisiana Architect*, and this matter shall be reported to the National Council of Architectural Registration Boards ("NCARB") Disciplinary Database, all identifying Respondent by name; and

6. This Consent Order shall not become effective unless and until it is accepted and signed by and on behalf of the Board. Should the Board not accept and sign this Consent Order, it is agreed that presentation of this matter to the Board shall not prejudice the Board or any of its members, staff, attorneys, or representatives from further participation, consideration, or resolution of any further proceedings herein.
